ATTENDANCE

When is it OK to not go to school?

An OK reason is one that prevents your child from getting to school. This could include:

- when your child is sick or unwell
- attending cultural or religious observances such as sorry time and funerals
- an unavoidable natural event such as flood waters or a cyclone
- unavoidable medical appointment
- The principal decides if the reason given for your child's absence is acceptable.

It's NOT OK to miss school if your child:

- is celebrating a birthday
- is going on a family holiday
- is visiting family and friends
- has slept in or had a big weekend

- is looking after other children
- has sport or other recreational that have not been activities approved by the school
- and minor check ups
- other health appointments should be made either before or after school, or during the school holidays.
