

VAPING

At Dongara DHS we do not tolerate possession of, or use of Vapes. Students in possession of, or using a vape at school will be suspended and lose Good Standing.

Understand the laws around selling vapes in Western Australia.

It is reported that young people often purchase vapes online, from retail stores or from friends and contacts in the community. However, it is illegal in WA to sell ecigarette devices and nicotine vaping products to anyone regardless of age, unless they are prescribed by a doctor for smoking cessation purposes and obtained with a prescription from a pharmacy.

In WA e-cigarette devices and their components, whether or not they contain nicotine, cannot be sold by tobacco or general retailers. It is also illegal to sell vapes to friends at school or in the community.

If you suspect someone is selling vapes or e-cigarettes and their components,
