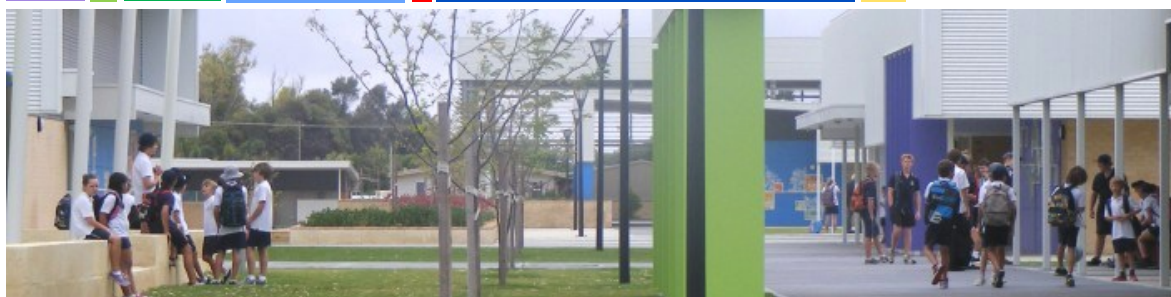

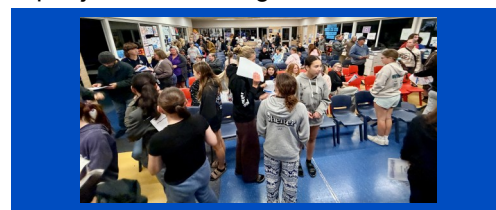
Thanks to everyone who dressed up for **Super Hero Day** to raise money to support the **Irwin St John Sub Centre**.

WA Student Assistance Payment

WA Student Assistance Payment – Round 3

Parents and carers of school-aged children can now claim the third round of the **WA Student Assistance Payment**.

Eligible WA students from **Kindergarten to Year 12** can receive:

- **\$150** for each Kindergarten and primary school student
- **\$250** for each secondary school student

To be eligible, students must be enrolled in a WA school.

Claims open from **Monday, 20 July 2026**.

To submit your claim, you will need your child's **8-digit WA Student Number**. If you need assistance locating your child's student number, please contact or visit the school administration office.

How to claim

Claims can be submitted:

- Through the **ServiceWA** app
- Online at www.education.wa.edu.au/wasap
- By completing and submitting a paper claim form.

Claims close on **Friday, 25 September 2026**.



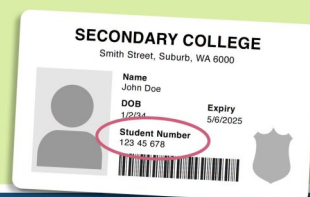

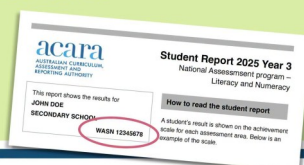


Sometimes it's called a: SCSA or student number
